Student Code of Conduct

Wherever there is a group of people working, learning or playing together, a Code of Conduct is necessary to ensure harmonious interaction. The Code establishes clear parameters of acceptable behaviour so that the environment is fair and just for all participants. A school is no exception. We believe that the following rules will promote a happy, cooperative and Christian learning environment.

General principles

- Use language that is pure, kind and true
- Conduct oneself in a manner that is courteous toward and respectful of the feelings and rights of others
- Look after school property and promptly report any damage to a teacher
- Refrain from bringing onto school property any items that may be used to hurt or injure others or to damage school property
- Refrain from dishonesty, stealing, cheating, lying and deception, which are not tolerated at school

Specific Principles

- Students are required to remain at school under teacher supervision
- When the bell rings at the end of play periods, play must cease and all sporting equipment be returned to its proper place for storage
- Students are required to play safely in the areas designated for play
- School bags are to be kept neatly in the designated areas
- Always walk within the building or on the veranda
- All rubbish must be placed in the bins provided
- Wilful damage to property must be paid for by the student responsible
- All students are expected to attend their classes promptly
- Due to the possibility of personal injury and damage to clothing, rugby or rough play are not permitted at school
- Games that involve tackling or pulling people to the ground are not allowed



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Parent and Visitor Code of Conduct

A code of conduct for parents and visitors ensures that everyone who visits the School is able to do so in a safe and harmonious manner. The values of respect and positive relationships are paramount in our School and this Code of Conduct supports those values.

Parents and visitors to the School are to:

- Treat all persons associated with the school with respect and courtesy
- Make a prior appointment with a staff member if you wish to discuss a matter in detail
- Only enter a classroom on invitation from the teacher
- Allow staff to supervise, investigate and manage students without interference
- Use polite language in the presence of students, staff or other visitors
- Discuss issues or concerns about the school, staff or students by talking directly with the Principal or class teacher at an appropriate time. This includes emailing or messaging at appropriate times (8:30am – 4:00pm is appropriate times)
- Behave at all times in a manner that does not cause alarm or concern
- Follow school procedures governing entry and behaviour on school grounds, including any restrictions that may be imposed

Disregarding this Code of Conduct may result in restricted access to the School grounds.
